I am pleased to announce the appointment of Antoniette (Toni) M. Guglielmo, Ph.D. as Assistant Director of the Getty Leadership Institute (GLI) at Claremont Graduate University (CGU). As GLI's Assistant Director, Toni will partner with me to develop, market, and deliver GLI's programs to the museum field. She will serve as our chief administrator, manage our communications strategy, and work closely with CGU staff and faculty.

Toni brings an impressive background in museums and academia to the GLI. In 2011-2012, she was the Sylvan C. Coleman and Pamela Coleman Memorial Fund Fellow in the Department of Modern and Contemporary Art at the Metropolitan Museum of Art. Prior to her fellowship, she developed and managed an award-winning distance learning program at the Los Angeles County Museum of Art and served as the Assistant Director for the Museum of Creativity Project as well as a Project Associate at the Getty Education Institute for the Arts.

Dr. Guglielmo has taught in the museum and college classrooms at the J. Paul Getty Museum, Otis College of Art and Design, and the University of California, Riverside. She received a B.A. from the University of California, Los Angeles, an M.A. from Tufts University, and a Ph.D. from the University of California, Santa Barbara. Her scholarly research focuses on intersections between museums and consumer culture and she is interested in how history informs and advances current theory and practice in the museum field.
